2.1. The term ‘**Contribution**’ means the article written by the Author(s) as entitled on the first page of this LSPD and includes, without exception, all the versions of the article listed as follows:

2.1.1. **Submitted Manuscript Under Review (‘SMUR’)**: any version of the article submitted to the Journal that is under the formal double-blind peer review process for publication in the Journal.

2.1.2. **Accepted Manuscript (AM)**: the version of the Contribution which has been accepted for publication. This version may still include some revisions as an outcome of the peer review process and may be subject to further editorial input, such as some proofreading and editing by the Publisher.

2.1.3. **Version of Record (VoR)**: the version of the Contribution that is formally published in the Journal. This version includes Digital Object Identifier (DOI). This version does not need any other inputs such as proofreading, editing, layout and typesetting.

2.2. The term ‘**Supplementary Material**’ is used for any kind of material that can be either written or illustrated and that submitted to the Journal additionally to the Contribution by the Author for publication. Supplementary Material can be either an original content created by the Author or used and/or reproduced third-party material.

2.3. In consideration of publication, the Author hereby chooses the type of the publication in terms of copyrights. The choices subject to this LSPD are as follows:
